Saturday 4th May

- 8.30 Arrival of coach at Goring Heath Hall car park

- 10am Meet at Goring Heath Hall car park for coach/car journey to Savill Gardens.
Postcode TW20 0UJ for car drivers. Suggested route – Henley, Hurley, join M4 at junction 8, leave at junction 6 on the A355, then A 308, following brown signs to Savill Gardens.
- 11.30 Coach to park in coach park, cars in general car park. **DO NOT** buy a ticket. Wait by coach and you will be brought your garden tickets. Car drivers to take their tickets to the reception desk to redeem their free parking tickets.
- 2.15 Assemble at coach/cars for short journey to Runnymede, French Brothers, postcode SL4 5JH. Park on National Trust grass verge, on left, as near to tree line as possible.
- 2.45 Board the boat for the return trip along River Thames – cream tea served halfway.
- 4.45 Depart French Brothers for return to Goring Heath car park, arriving at about 6pm.
